

Finally, this legislation will save Medicare billions of dollars by fighting waste, fraud, and abuse. It requires the Department of Health and Human Services to institute a new screening process for all providers and suppliers before granting Medicare billing privilege and provides the states with new authority to impose screening procedures on Medicaid providers. It also increases funding for the Health Care Fraud and Abuse Control Fund to fight Medicare and Medicaid fraud.
