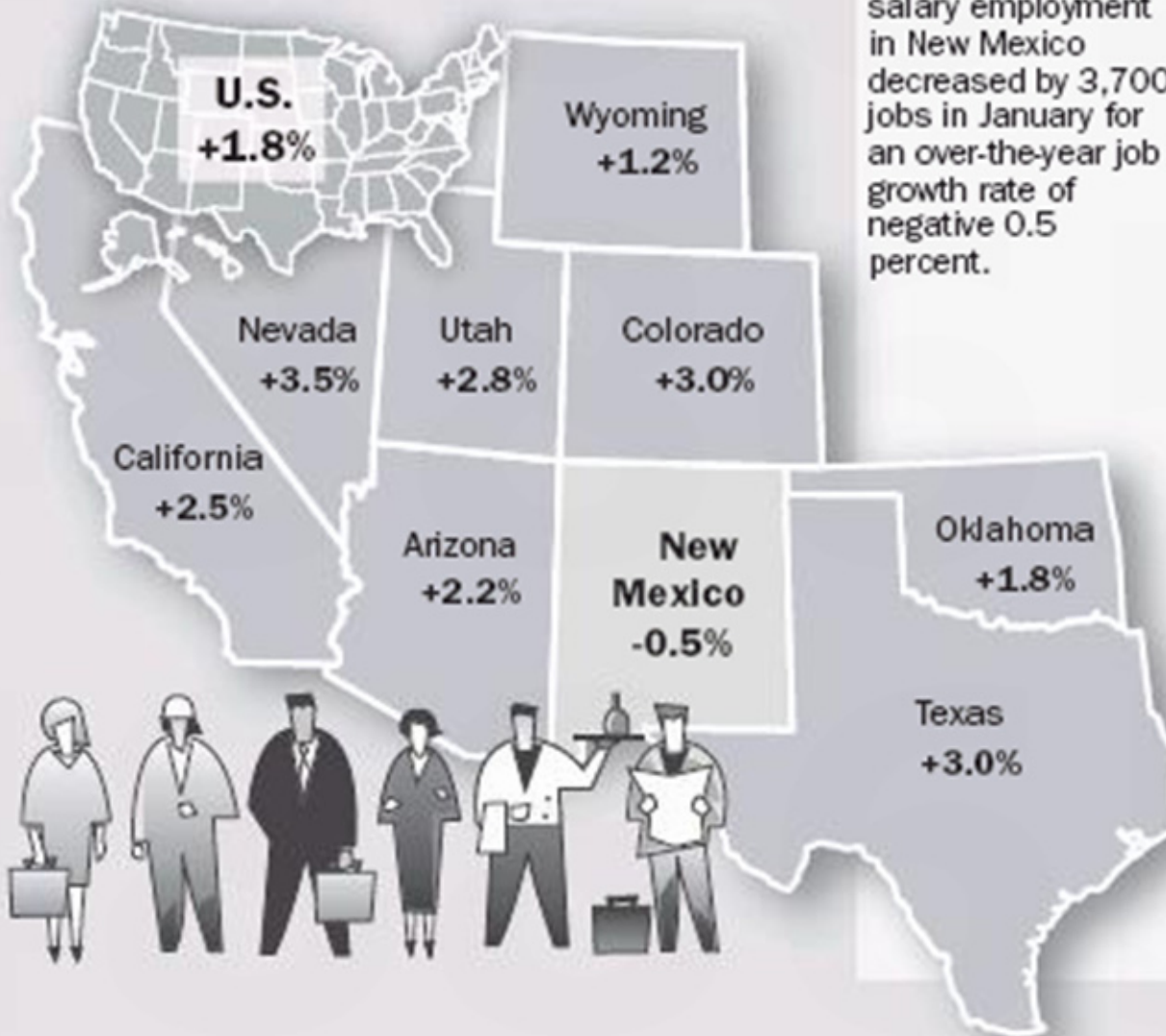


REGIONAL EMPLOYMENT GROWTH

EMPLOYMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- Nonfarm wage and salary employment in New Mexico decreased by 3,700 jobs in January for an over-the-year job growth rate of negative 0.5 percent.
- Albuquerque employment has decreased by 4,100 jobs for an over-the-year job growth rate of negative 1.1 percent.
- Las Cruces employment has increased by 0.3 percent.
- Nonfarm employment has increased by 0.5 percent in the Santa Fe area, representing a gain of 300 jobs.
- Nonfarm employment in the Farmington area decreased by 700 jobs for an over-the-year job growth rate of negative 1.4 percent.
